10. The Southern Region Hearing Board heard and granted the following emergency variances since July 2018:

A. S-18-35E California Resources Production Corporation

On August 28, 2018, Hearing Board Chair, William Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from August 27, 2018, through September 26, 2018. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, and 4623, and allowed for the storage of organic liquids in tanks without a functional and operating VRS.

B. S-18-36E Mount Poso Cogeneration Company

On September 11, 2018, Hearing Board Chair, William Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from September 9, 2018, through October 8, 2018. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4001, and 4352, and allowed for the continued operation of the facility without a fully functional CEMS.

C. S-18-39E California Resources Production Corporation

On September 24, 2018, Hearing Board Chair, William Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from September 21, 2018, through October 20, 2018. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2520, and 4409, and allowed for an extension of repair period while CRPC schedules a workover rig to come to the facility and complete repairs.

D. S-18-40E Calgren Renewable Fuels

On September 25, 2018, Hearing Board Chair, William Bland, acting for and on behalf of the Southern Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from September 25, 2018, through September 27, 2018. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070 and 2201, and allowed for the continued operation of the ethanol plant while the RTO is offline.
