On July 8, 2004, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from July 13, 2004, to July 14, 2004. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 4001, and 4623 and allowed the storage of petroleum products in tanks without an operational VRS for up to 24 hours.

B. Docket #S-04-36E – Chevron USA, Inc.
Section 31E OCP, Taft, CA

On July 27, 2004, Hearing Board Chairman, Mr. Hollis Carlile, approved an emergency variance effective from August 15, 2004, to September 13, 2004. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 and allows the shutdown of the VRS serving the seven subject tanks while leaks in the heat exchanger are repaired.
