5. The Southern Region Hearing Board approved the following emergency variances orders:

- A. Docket S-06-64E – Chevron USA Inc.

On November 8, 2006, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance from November 8, 2006, to December 7, 2006. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0 and 4623, and allow the continued operation of the subject tanks until the isolation valves are repaired/replaced and the maintenance is completed on the subject vapor recovery systems, pressure relief devices, and the 31E vapor recovery compressor and the steam generators are restarted and the VRS is operational.

B. Docket S-06-65E – Chevron USA Inc.

On December 1, 2006, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance from November 29, 2006, to December 28, 2006. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070.7.0, 4305, and 4306, and allowed CUSA to postpone the required monthly monitoring until the steam generator is returned to normal operation.
