5. The Southern Region Hearing Board approved the following emergency variance order:

- A. Docket #S-05-86E – Chevron USA Inc.

On January 4, 2006, Hearing Board member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from January 9, 2006, to February 8, 2006. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 to allow continued storage of VOC containing fluids in the subject equipment without an operational VRS for the time necessary to replace the compressor lube oil pump motor.

B. Docket #S-06-01E – Chevron USA Inc.

On January 4, 2006, Hearing Board member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from January 3, 2006, to February 1, 2006. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 to allow the subject tanks, heater treaters, and FWKO vessels to continue storing VOC containing fluids without an operational VRS during the PG&E electrical outage.

C. Docket #S-06-02E – ExxonMobile Production Company

On January 4, 2006, Hearing Board member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from January 3, 2006, to February 1, 2006. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 to allow the subject tanks and oil/water separators to continue storing VOC containing fluids without an operational VRS during the PG&E electrical outage.

D. Docket #S-06-03E – Aera Energy LLC

On January 4, 2006, Hearing Board member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from January 4, 2006, to January 10, 2006. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 to allow the subject tanks and vessels to continue storing VOC containing fluids without an operational VRS during the electrical outage.

E. Docket #S-06-05E – ExxonMobile Production Company

On January 11, 2006, Hearing Board member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from January 11, 2006, to February 9, 2006. Said variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 to allow the subject tanks to be isolated from VRS so that they can be degassed, drained, and cleaned prior to being repaired.
