On March 6, 2002, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective for two, thirty-minute periods between March 6, 2002, and April 5, 2002. Said variance provides relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0 and 4623, as they pertain to the release of excess VOC emissions associated with the temporary shutdown of the vapor collection system while electrical power was transitioned off and on to the PG&E grid.

On March 21, 2002, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from March 27, 2002, and March 28, 2002. Said variance provides relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0 and 4623, as they pertain to the release of excess VOC emissions associated with the temporary shutdown of the vapor recovery system during the installation and disconnection of portable generator units.

On March 29, 2002, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective for a 16-hour period between March 29, 2002, and April 18, 2002. Said variance provides relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0 and 4623, as they pertain to the release of excess VOC emissions associated with the temporary shutdown of several steam generators and the vapor recovery system while repair/replacement of a leaking high pressure valve is conducted.
