On October 10, 2003, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from November 10, 2003, to November 28, 2003. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0 and 4623 and allowed the tanks to be isolated from the VRS while maintenance and inspection activities were conducted.
