On April 16, 2003, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective for a sixteenhour period between April 16, 2003, and April 23, 2003. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0 and 4623, and allowed continued operation of five petroleum storage tanks while isolated form the VRS to accommodate the replacement of a leaking vapor compressor.

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> B. <u>Docket #S-03-13E</u> – ExxonMobil Production Company 18271 Highway 33, McKittrick, CA 93251

On April 22, 2003, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective between April 22, 2003, and April 26, 2003. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623, and allowed three produced water storage tanks to be isolated from the VRS while maintenance and inspection activities were conducted.
