On September 17, 2003, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from September 17, 2003, to September 30, 2003. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 and allowed the T031 clarifier tank to be isolated from the vapor recovery system (VRS) while cleaning activities were conducted.

- B. Docket #S-03-33E – Aera Energy LLC

On September 30, 2003, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from October 21, 2003, to November 20, 2003. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 and allowed the VRS associated with this crude oil production facility to be shut down while electrical system upgrades were made.

On September 17, 2003, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from September 17, 2003, to September 30, 2003. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4701 and allowed the use of three stand-by generator units outside the permitted operating periods.
