5. Emergency Variances:

The Southern Region Hearing Board approved the following emergency variance orders:

- A. Docket #S-04-14E – Equilon Enterprises LLC
6451 Rosedale Highway, Bakersfield, CA

On March 3, 2004, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from March 9, 2004, to March 23, 2004. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rule 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 and allowed the storage of organic materials without a functioning VRS while the VRS header was hydro blasted to remove an obstruction.

- B. Docket #S-04-15E – Equilon Enterprises LLC
6451 Rosedale Highway, Bakersfield, CA

On March 12, 2004, Hearing Board Chairman, Hollis B. Carlile approved an emergency variance effective from March 15, 2004, to April 14, 2004. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 and would allow tank T-900A to be isolated of from the VRS and opened to the atmosphere in order to repair leaking explosive door seals.

- C. Docket #S-04-17E – Equilon Enterprises LLC
6451 Rosedale Highway, Bakersfield, CA

On March 17, 2004, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from March 18, 2004, to March 21, 2004. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 and allowed the temporary isolation and shutdown of the VRS serving seven storage tanks in order to clean plugged vapor lines.

- D. Docket #S-04-18E – Aera Energy LLC
Section NE35, Township 12N, Range 24W, Kern Co, CA

On March 17, 2004, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from March 22, 2004, to March 31, 2004. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 and allowed the storage of petroleum materials without vapor recovery during electrical power transfers resulting from a PG&E power outage.

- E. Docket #S-04-21E – Equilon Enterprises LLC
6451 Rosedale Highway, Bakersfield, CA

On March 19, 2004, Hearing Board Chairman, Hollis B. Carlile, approved an emergency variance effective from March 19, 2004, to April 18, 2004. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, and 4623 and would allow the vapor recovery lines connected to Tank numbers 901, 903, 910, 914, 909B and the vapor recovery header from these tanks to be disconnected from the vapor recovery compressor for cleaning purposes.
