5. Emergency Variances:

The Southern Region Hearing Board approved the following emergency variance orders:

- A. Docket #S-04-11E – Aera Energy LLC
29235 Highway 33, Maricopa, CA

On February 23, 2004, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from February 17, 2004, to February 26, 2004. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rule 2070.7.0 and allowed the storage of organic materials without a functioning VRS while electrical power is switched from MSCC back to PG&E.

- B. Docket #S-04-12E – Equilon Enterprises LLC

On February 26, 2004, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from March 2, 2004, to March 9, 2004. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0 and 4623 and allowed for the shutdown of the VRS to accommodate the reconnection of the 73T1 bladder tank and subsequent system testing.

On February 26, 2004, Hearing Board Member Ms. Kimm Wolber, RN, COHN-S, approved an emergency variance effective from February 26 2004, to March 26, 2004. Said variance provided relief from the requirements of District Rule 4663 and allowed the use of surface preparation and cleaning solvent that contained 860 g/l VOC in order to complete the application of a rubber repair patch.
