Alberta/Finley/Shale Lease Midway Sunset Oil Field

Petitioners: Robert Beebout, Timothy Perkins

AERA has requested a short variance from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520 and 4623, in addition to the applicable conditions of the subject PTOs. The requested variance would be for a consecutive 96-hour

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period to occur sometime between April 15, 2011 and July 11, 2011. If granted, the variance would allow the continued storage of VOC containing liquids without a functional or operating TVR system while AERA isolates tank F-104.

B. S-11-13S Short Aera Energy, LLC

Wier Lease

Midway Sunset Oil Field

AERA has requested a short variance from the requirements of District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520 and 4623, in addition to the applicable conditions of the subject PTOs. The requested variance would be for a consecutive 96-hour period to occur sometime between May 1, 2011 and July 29, 2011. If granted, the variance would allow the continued storage of VOC containing liquids in the petroleum storage tanks without a functional or operating TVR system while AERA replaces the electrical relay.

Having decided the petition has met the required findings, on motion of Mr. Bland, seconded by Ms. Wolber, unanimously passed, the petitioner was granted a short variance.

C. S-11-14S Short Alon Bakersfield Property, Inc.

Selas Heater

Petitioners: Brian Pellens

ALON has requested a short variance from District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, 4306 and 4320 in addition to conditions of the applicable PTOs. The requested variance period would for a consecutive 30-hour period to occur sometime between May 1, 2011 to July 29, 2011. If granted, the variance would allow ALON to exceed the allowed start up time of heater 20-H11.

Brian Pellens thanked Mr. Houlihan for the excellent staff report. Mr. Pellens offered further explanation of the heater functions.

D. S-11-15S Short Alon Bakersfield Property, Inc.

Limited Turnaround 6451 Rosedale Hwy Bakersfield, CA 93308

Petitioners: Brian Pellens

ALON has requested a short variance from District Rules, 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520 and 4623, in addition to conditions of the applicable PTOs. The requested short variance period would be for a consecutive 5-day period to occur between April 14, 2011 and July 12, 2011. If granted, the variance would allow ALON to store VOC containing liquids in the storage tanks without a functional or operating VRS while they perform a limited refinery turnaround.

Brian Pellens thanked Mr. Houlihan for the excellent staff report.

Mr. Houlihan suggested that due to the extensive and complicated work involved, a change be made to the petition to read as follows:

The requested short variance period would be for a consecutive 10-day period to occur sometime between April 14, 2011 and July 12, 2011.

Condition number one on page four would read as follows:

The variance shall be for a consecutive 10-day period to occur sometime between April 14, 2011 and July 12, 2011or until the VRS is restarted, whichever come first.

The District approved the requested change.

Having decided the petition has met the required findings, on motion of Ms. Wolber, seconded by Mr. Stovall, unanimously passed, the petitioner was granted a short variance subject to the amended conditions.
