AERA has requested a short variance from District Rule 4320. The requested short variance period would be effective between July 1, 2011 and September 28, 2011. If granted, the variance would allow AERA to continue to burn fuel with a sulfur content

greater than 5 grains of sulfur per 100 scf in the steam generators at the 401 Steam Generator Setting.

B. S-11-28S Short Chevron USA Inc.

Monterey Central Plant Kern River Oil Field Bakersfield, CA

CUSA has requested a short variance from the requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520 and 4401, and 4623 in addition to conditions of the applicable Authorities to Construct (ATCs) and Permits to Operate (PTOs). The requested short variance period would be effective for a consecutive 24-hour period to occur sometime between June 8, 2011 and September 6, 2011. If granted, the variance would allow for the continued storage of VOC containing liquids in the subject petroleum storage tanks without a functional or operating VRS while the fin-fan cooler is repaired.

CUSA has requested a short variance from District Rules 2010, 2201, 2070.7.0, 2520, and 4623, in addition to conditions of the applicable Authorities to Construct (ATCs) and Permits to Operate (PTOs). The requested short variance period would effective for a consecutive 14-day period to occur sometime between June 8, 2011 to September 3, 2011. If granted, the variance would allow CUSA to continue to store VOC containing liquids in tanks without a functional or operating VRS while CUSA conducts the start up and testing on the VRS compressor.

CUSA requested a language change in Condition four on page five of the report.

CUSA shall notify the District as least 24 hours, but no later than 96 hours prior to each planned shut down of the VRS and will notify the District within two hours after each unplanned shut down.
