A. S-11-49S Short Aera Energy, LLC

Section 20, Dehydration Facility

Belridge Oil Field

Petitioners: Sam Parks, Lucas Chambers

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AERA has requested a short variance from District Rules 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4623, in addition to conditions of the applicable PTOs. The requested short variance would be for a consecutive period of 8 hours to occur sometime between September 15, 2011, and November 15, 2011. If granted, the short variance would allow for the continued storage of VOC containing liquids in the tanks without a functional or operating VRS while AERA replaces the UPS.

Mr. Parks agreed with the staff report. The petitioner had nothing further to add.

Having decided the petition has met the required findings, on motion of Ms. Wolber, seconded by Ms. Carpenter, unanimously passed, the petitioner was granted a short variance.

B. S-11-52S Short Chevron USA Inc. Station 2-22 & Station 31 Midway Sunset oil Field

Petitioners: Martin Lundy, David Moore

CUSA has requested a short variance from District Rules 2010, 2070.7.0, 2201, 2520, and 4623, in addition to conditions of the applicable Authorities to Construct (ATCs) and Permits to Operate (PTOs). The requested short variance period would be for a consecutive 3-day period to occur sometime between September 14, 2011, and December 12, 2011. If granted, the variance would allow for the continued storage of VOC containing liquids in the tanks and vessels without a functional or operating VRS while CUSA implements the electrical upgrades.

Mr. Lundy thanked Mr. Houlihan for his accurate report. Mr. Moore stated that the actual work time needed is 18 hours but CUSA requested three days in case there were unexpected problems.
