The requested variance period would be for a non-consecutive 336 hour period to occur sometime between September 18, 2017, and December 16, 2017, inclusive. If granted, the variance would allow Chevron to continue to store VOC containing liquids in the subject tanks without an operating or functional VRS while they conduct the maintenance and upgrades at the 26C OCP. In addition, it

allow wells with closed casing gas vents to produce into tanks that do not have a functional or operating VRS.

Mr. Haddock asked for clarification on why allowance of excess emissions of VOC are estimated to be at 4,318 pounds.
