Both parties entered into a Stipulated Order of Abatement to require Mattivi to cease operation of the 1372 horsepower diesel engine powering an electrical generator unless conditions of the prescribed order are met. Mattivi wishes to continue to use the Tier 2 engine for a period of time as there are no Tier 4 engines of this horsepower paired with an electrical generator.

Chevron has requested a short variance from the applicable of District Rules 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4001 and 4703, in addition to the applicable conditions of the subject permits. If granted, the variance would allow continued operation of the co-generation turbines without an operational CEMS while the breaker for the sample line heat trace is replaced.
