If granted, the variance would allow Chevron to bypass the 17Z while not following all the provisions of District Rule 4409 during the turnaround, allow the continued storage of VOC containing liquids in the two drain tanks without an operating and functional VCS, and allow the flare at the CAHN 3 to exceeds its daily throughput.
