Crimson has requested a short variance from applicable requirements of District Rules 2070 and 4623, in addition to applicable conditions of the subject permits. The requested variance period would be from June 1, 2019, to May 31, 2020, inclusive. If granted, it would allow Crimson to continue to produce into tanks without vapor recovery while they develop and implement a plan to bring the tanks under the necessary vapor control for large producers.

Petitioner Comments: Mr. Nixon reiterated that these are small facilities and some are in remote areas, so they are evaluating the best course of action for each location.
