The Interim variance shall be effective for a cumulative 30-hour period to occur sometime between April 7, 2006 and July 5, 2006, until the date of decision of the Hearing Board on the application of the associated regular variance, or until such time that both tank vapor recovery units (A & B) are fully operational, all adjustments and repairs have been made to the tank vapor recovery units, the three wash tanks are operational, and connected to the vapor recovery system (VRS), and CUSA has had sufficient time to evaluate the reliability of the VRS, whichever occurs first. The eleven recommended conditions will be set forth in the Southern Region Hearing Board Order.*
