William L. Bland, Jr., indicated to Philip M. Jay, District Counsel that he had a potential conflict of interest pertaining to Sierra Power Corporation. After discussing the issue Mr. Jay advised Mr. Bland to excuse himself from participating in the hearing for Sierra Power Corporation. Therefore, Mr. Bland took a seat in the audience.
