**Decision** – Board Member Bland made the motion to grant the Short Variance to Docket S-03-37S, Equilon Enterprises LLC., subject to thirteen conditions set forth on pages 3 and 4 of the Staff Report with amendments to #1, #6, #7, #10 and #11. The Board concurred the required six findings set forth on pages 2 and 3 of the Staff Report be adopted by reference. Seconded by Board Member Wolber and carried unanimously with the following <u>**Roll Call Vote**</u>:

The Board granted a Short Variance to Docket S-03-37S, Equilon Enterprises LLC. The variance shall be effective for a maximum of 48 hours to occur sometime between November 18, 2003 and February 15, 2004. The following conditions amended as follows:

- 1. The variance shall be effective for a maximum of 48 hours to occur sometime between November 18, 2003 and <del>December 31, 2003 February <u>15, 2004.</u></del>
- 6. No Net increase in VOC <u>or H2S</u> emissions is authorized by this variance.
- 7. The pressure relief vents shall be monitored <u>for VOCs and H2S</u> once every two-hours while VRS #8 is offline and records kept to determine if tank venting occurred while the VRS was offline.
- 10. A return to full compliance with District Rules and requirements shall be achieved as soon as practicable, but no later than midnight <del>December 31, 2003</del> <u>February 15, 2004</u>.

11. By January 10, 2004 February 25, 2004, or no later than 10 days after compliance is achieved, whichever occurs first, the Petitioner shall submit a written report to the District that includes the following: The thirteen conditions with amendments will be set forth in the Order.
