RECOMMENDATION:

In accordance with the Governing Board Officer Selection Policies adopted by your Board on January 15, 2001 and amended on December 20, 2001, elect Chair and Vice Chair of your Governing Board for 2010 as follows:

- Vice Chair shall be the representative from Madera County

BACKGROUND:

On December 20, 2001 your Board adopted the current Chair Rotation Schedule as a guide for this process. The Chair Rotation Schedule designates that the Chair and Vice Chair will be selected annually based on a county rotation.

In the past, the positions of secretary, treasurer, auditor-controller and attorney have been held by non-Board Members. Your board appointed the Fresno County Treasurer as SJVAPSA Treasurer and the District Executive Director/APCO as SJVAPSA Auditor-Controller. Legal, administrative and financial functions are being performed by District staff.

Officers. "The board shall select a chairman and vice chairman, and other necessary officials, including a secretary, treasurer, auditor-controller and attorney."

(Joint Powers Agreement, Section 3.D)

<u>Chair Rotation.</u> Chair and Vice Chair are selected annually to serve on a calendar year basis using a pre-established rotational system, which designates the county represented. Vice Chair succeeds to Chair the following year. Members shall not serve as Chair during their first year on the Board. The rotational system to implement this policy is shown below:
