The purpose of this rule amendment project is to reduce the District's annual operating deficit by proposing an increase in fees by 8%, effective July 1, 2025 and by 8%, effective July 1, 2026 for the rules listed above.

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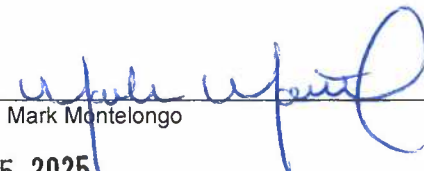

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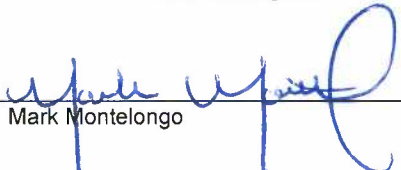

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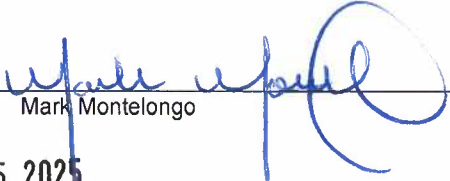
