NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Unified Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed issuance of Emission Reduction Credits to UPF Corp for shutdown of a fiberglass filament manufacturing facility, at 3747 Standard Street, Bakersfield, CA. The quantity of ERCs proposed for banking is 2,951 lb-NOx/yr, 7,428 lb-PM10/yr, 2,242 lb-CO/yr and 8,354 lb-VOC/yr.
