

**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT AND
THE PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION OF FEDERALLY
MANDATED OPERATING PERMIT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District solicits public comment on the proposed significant modification of California Dairies at 2000 N. Plaza Dr., Visalia, California. California Dairies proposes to modify three existing boilers (S-7063-8-9, '9-9, and '18-6) by installing Selective Catalytic Reduction (SCR) to each, replacing their burners, and removing a current limit of operating only 2 boilers concurrently, in addition to modifying their source testing date requirements.
